In this report, we will discuss how to find profitable keywords by Brainstorm Generator and explore more ideas through Wikipedia.org.

First, download the [free version of Brainstorm Generator](#).

Let we look at these 3 steps.

Step 1: Use “**Froogle**” or “**Websource**” mode to find keywords;

Step 2: Put this **keyword** in Google – “**site:en.wikipedia.org keyword**”; Replace keyword with the niche you have found.

Step 3: Put this wikipedia.org URL in Brainstorm Generator.

Let we do an example here.

Step 1: Use Froogle or Websource to find keywords

- Open your brain.exe
- Check Froogle or Websource mode
- Select “AdSense Publisher”
- DONE
